Novice Senior Class: for boys and girls at least 15 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: for boys and girls at least 9 years and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: for boys and girls at least 12 years and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: for boys and girls at least 15 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: for boys and girls at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show and who have won 10 first place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar year for this class will be November 1 to October 31 of the following year. AKC Trick Dog Testing

Do you and your dog love to be the life of the party by showing off his arsenal of tricks? Then he might be perfectly primed to earn AKC Trick Dog titles! AKC Trick Dog titles are official AKC titles listed on the dog's title record.

The processing fee for each title is \$25. Multiple titles for the same dog can be sent in together, each one will be processed in succession after each previous title has been added and printed.

Dogs must have an AKC, PAL, or AKC Canine Partners number to earn a title.

All dogs can get a number including purebreds and mixed breeds.

There are five AKC Trick Titles you and your dog can earn:

- ✚ **AKC Novice Trick Dog (TKN)** - Your dog performs 10 skills from the Novice list. If a dog has a Canine Good Citizen (CGC) certificate or title on record at AKC, the dog can do 5 Novice tricks (CGC + 5) to earn the Novice title.
- ✚ **AKC Intermediate Trick Dog (TKI)** – Your dog must have the Novice title, plus perform 10 Intermediate tricks.
- ✚ **AKC Advanced Trick Dog (TKA)** – Your dog must have the Intermediate title, plus perform 10 tricks from the Advanced list.
- ✚ **AKC Trick Dog Performer (TKP)** – In this title, handlers perform a short routine with at least 10 tricks with at least 3 tricks using props.
- ✚ **AKC Trick Dog Elite Performer (TKE)** – In the highest level of Trick Dog, the Elite Performers perform a routine that has a story/script.
- ✚ At least 5 props are used. See link for lists of skills.

AKC Temperament Testing

The ATT is a noncompetitive pass-fail test in which dogs are tested on the following six categories: Social, Auditory, Visual, Tactile (touch), Proprioceptive (motion) and an Unexpected Stimulus. In a test, the dog must pass 3 test items in each of the six categories (total of 18 test items). These are selected by the evaluators from a list of 24 possible test items. All dogs who pass the ATT under two different approved ATT Evaluators may earn the AKC Temperament Test (ATT) Title. The ATT is administered only by AKC licensed or member clubs. The ATT may be held in conjunction with another AKC event or as a standalone (AKC club) event.

Dogs may wear slip collars that are on the dead ring, buckle collars, martingales and body harnesses in the ATT. Prong collars, head collars, ecollars, or harnesses that restrict the movement of the dog are not allowed. Leashes should be 4ft. to 6ft. long and should be made of fabric or leather.

ATT testing is open to all breeds & mixed breeds with AKC number.

GC Testing Information

The CGC TEST consists of 10 skills needed by all well-mannered dogs (All exercises are done on a leash).

1. Accepting a friendly stranger (Handshake With Evaluator (greeting)
2. Sitting politely for petting.
3. Appearance and grooming.
4. Out for a walk (walking on a loose lead)
5. Walking through a crowd.
6. Sit and down on command and stay in place.
7. Coming when called.
8. Reaction to another dog.
9. Reaction to distraction.
10. Supervised separation.
